# Wilmington City Road Program...FAQ Demystified!



The Road Maintenance program for 2024 in the City of Wilmington is currently underway. This year's program includes a range of activities aimed at either **rehabilitating failing pavements**, or **preserving pavements** that are still in good condition.

The work to **preserve the existing pavement** consists of one or more of the following techniques:

Crackfill Rejuvenation Microsurfacing

These techniques are intended to extend the life of our existing pavements at a fraction of the cost of rehabilitation.

**Crackfilling** is intended to seal existing cracks in the pavement to prevent continued damage caused by water and ice.

The **rejuvenator** is a topically applied solution intended to renew suitable pavements that have aged and oxidized. The rejuvenator restores the properties of the asphalt to a near-new condition.

**Microsurfacing** is a method that appears similar to traditional paving but has many distinct differences. As stated, Microsurfacing is a preservation technique that is intended to extend the life of existing suitable pavements at a fraction of the cost of traditional paving. Microsurfacing is applied as a thin layer over existing pavement. This layer consists of a sand and emulsion mixture that spreads much like a liquid and requires cure time prior to being driven on. Driving on this material prior to curing will result in permanent wheel marks. Additionally the finished appearance of this material can be affected by the pavement it's being applied to. Ridges and minor high spots left as part of the installation process are normal and will become less pronounced with use.



The **pavement rehabilitation** process involves removing the deteriorated surface, patching as needed, and repaving the road with hot mix asphalt.


