

KNITTING KIT



Kit includes:


- 10 inch aluminum knitting needles (two sets): size 3 & size 5
- 13.8 inch aluminum knitting needles (four sets): sizes 3, 5, 7, & 10
- Knifty Knitter (4 round looms: small, medium, large, & extra large)
- Sample project/pattern
- 2 skeins of yarn (more available in our Yarn Gifting Library!)

Kit does NOT include:

- Hook/pick for Knifty Knitter

A crochet hook may be used in place of the hook/pick tool that comes with the original Knifty Knitter kit. Here is a great tutorial video about this method:

 Scrap Yarn Gloves


Yarn: Knit Picks Chroma Worsted (Colour - Mix Tape)
70% Wool 30% Nylon 100 grams / 198 yards
I used half a ball left over from a scarf I made.

Needle Size: 4.5mm / US #7 - dpn

Garment Size: Small (Medium, Large)

Gauge: 5 sts x 7 rows = 1 inch

Timing: An evening watching TV



Cast on 30 (34, 38) sts.
Knit K1, P1 rib in a circle for 15 rows [Row 15]
Knit stockinette for 10 rows [Row 25]
Thumb placement - On the next row, slip the first stitch and knit to the end of the round. Do not connect the round, instead turn and purl back to the other end of the round, slipping the first stitch purlwise. Continue in this manner for 14 rows [Row 39]
Row 40: Knit in stockinette, continuing to knit in the round instead of turning for 13 rows [Row 52]
Row 53: Knit in a K1 P1 rib for 6 rounds [Row 58]
Bind off loosely in rib. When finished binding off, cut a tail of about 12" and pull through last stitch. Then slip the needle through the beginning of the first stitch on the round to close up the small gap. Secure and weave in the ends.
