We kindly remind all residents and business owners that it's their responsibility to clear these snow berms from the corners, ensuring they are moved onto the parkway rather than back into the street.

Additionally, please remember that on-street parking is prohibited by City Ordinance Section 76.01 during snowfalls of 1 inch or more.





Do you have too many Christmas decorations cluttering up your storage areas? Maybe last year's Christmas style is not going to cut it this year, but you'd rather spend the money on gifts. Join us for our annual Christmas decoration exchange on December 4th, 2024.
